His Eminence Grand Ayatollah Sayyid Mohammed Saeed al-Hakeem clarifies to the EU and Belgian Ambassadors the stance of Marji'iyya in educating the people on their genuine Islamic identity as taught by the Holy Prophet and the Holy Imams (peace be upon the

His Eminence Grand Ayatollah Sayyid Mohammed Saeed al-Hakeem received the Ambassador of the EU in Iraq, Ramon Blecua, and the Ambassador of Belgium in Iraq, Hendrik Van de Velde, on 9 April 2019.

His Eminence explained to the EU and Belgian Ambassadors in Iraq the role of Marji'iyya in propagating and delivering the true and genuine Islamic culture, which was taught by the Holy Prophet of Islam (peace be upon him and his progeny), and then his Holy Progeny (peace be upon them) after his passing away.
